

## SERVICES

Area Vice-Presidents are elected to represent specific groups of clusters as designated by the Board of Directors and approved by the Council. They are assisted by Cluster Coordinators, who represent each high school cluster. MCCPTA Committee Chairs, who are members of local PTAs throughout Montgomery County, also serve on the Board of Directors, bringing a multiplicity of perspectives and expertise to the table. Together they represent the local PTAs on the MCCPTA Board of Directors, assist in organizing new PTAs, keep in close communication with their member PTAs, and serve on committees of MCCPTA. Workshops for officers, delegates, and committee chairpersons of local PTAs are held each year. Officers and committee chairs are available to answer questions and give advice upon request.

**EPI** – Activities for children sponsored by MCCPTA through Educational Programs, Inc. include Foreign Languages in the Elementary Schools (FLES), Hands on Science (HOS), and the Cultural Arts Showcases (see MCCPTA-EPI, pp. 28).
