The MCCPTA Membership Committee is working with our local PTA/PTSA leaders to grow membership to increase our collective voice for the children of Montgomery County and the resources available to our local schools. With roughly 50,000 members in 2009-10, the committee seeks an overall increase of 50% to 75,000 members in 2010-11.

This summer, over two dozen membership leaders—PTA and PTSA presidents, vice presidents, and membership chairs—attended membership workshops in Rockville, Potomac, and Silver Spring to share ideas on reaching, building, and retaining membership despite the storms of July! Thanks to Kennedy High School and Hoover Middle School for their willingness to host these evening workshops, and to MCCPTA President Kristin Triple for quickly working with MCPS to locate space at Carver to reschedule one of these workshops at a convenient location for attendees.

Pending approval by the MCCPTA Board of Directors, the committee hopes to encourage membership growth with three categories of MCCPTA membership awards to be presented publicly at the Principals-Presidents Dinner in May 2011. Proposed awards would be given for a) percentage growth in local PTAs by 5% increments (5%, 10%, etc.); b) absolute numbers—the largest—PTA/PTSA by category of school (elementary, middle, high, or special school); and c) greatest parent involvement calculated by the ratio of the total number of students to total membership.
