Cluster coordinators and MCCPTA officers will be delivering testimony on modernizations of schools and other capital improvements to the Board of Education on November 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> at Carver Educational Services Center in Rockville. Kay Romero, President of the MCCPTA is scheduled to speak beginning at 7:00 pm on November 11<sup>th</sup>. The clusters tentatively scheduled for that evening are Northwood, Einstein, Montgomery Blair, Wheaton, Watkins Mill, Magruder, Gaithersburg, Clarksburg, Damascus, Whitman, Walter Johnson and Bethesda-Chevy Chase. The clusters currently scheduled to speak on November 12<sup>th</sup> are Seneca Valley, Poolesville, Quince Orchard, Northwest, Wootton, Richard Montgomery, Churchill, Sherwood, Blake, Paint Branch, and Springbrook. Hard copies of testimony will be available on request and electronic copies will appear on the MCCPTA website, [www.mccpta.com](http://www.mccpta.com), usually within two days of being delivered to the BOE.

Issues likely to be addressed include maintaining the modernization schedules for Paint Branch and Gaithersburg high schools, and making certain that funding is maintained for county-wide programs such as HVAC Replacement, Roof Replacement, Building Modifications and Program Improvements, Planned Life Cycle Asset Replacement and School Security Improvements.
